RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- whereas, District III Councilmember Randall Massey, Jr. on behalf of the East Fork community, has verbally presented a petition from the community requesting authorization from the Tribal Council to withdraw \$299.39 from the East Fork Land Claims fund to pay for the East Fork Community basketball court electric bill; and
- WHEREAS, Councilmember Massey avows that he will file a written community petition with signatures to the Tribal Council Secretary in the very near future; and
- WHEREAS, a copy of the electric bill is attached to this resolution and incorporated by reference herein; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with this request.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the withdrawal of \$299.39 from the East Fork Land Claims fund for the purpose of paying the attached electric bill for the East Fork Community basketball court.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 12, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
