RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the educational needs of the youngest members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe are the utmost importance; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has in the past indicated its support of early childhood education; and
- whereas, the Tribal Head Start Program has been invited to submit an application for the period from December, 1992 to November, 1993 in the amount of \$642,148.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes submission of the Head Start Grant in the amount of \$642,148.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it authorizes the Tribal Chairman, and in his absence, the Vice Chairman to sign any and all documents necessary to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 28, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of \underline{six} for and \underline{zero} against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) (j) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
