## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by Vice Chairman Lafe Altaha that a serious problem exists at the Whiteriver Cemetery as there is not enough land available for new burials and additional land must be surveyed and approved by the Tribal Council to allow for the expansion of the existing cemetery grounds as represented in the attached map of the area, incorporated by reference herein; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Tribal Planning Department is the appropriate department to conduct the survey and report its findings back to the Tribal Council.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
  Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Planning
  Department to conduct a survey and plan for expansion for
  the Whiteriver Cemetery as represented in the attached
  map incorporated by reference herein.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Tribal Planning Department should meet and confer with Vice Chairman Lafe Altaha prior to conducting the survey for the proposed cemetery expansion.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 09, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
