## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member, Renee Thomas, DOB: 07-28-1973 daughter of John Pat Thomas and Ethelyne Velasquez, has requested that her tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished so that she may become eligible for enrollment in the Tribe of her father John Pat Thomas, which is the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Tribe of Arizona; and
- whereas, the necessary documents of Relinquishment of Headrights were read and signed by Renee Thomas, in the presence of a Notary Public and are attached hereto.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Renee Thomas that her tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished this date.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 10, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III, Section 3 of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
