RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Councilmember Kino Kane advises the Tribal Council that Resolution No. 08-92-215 authorized HIP funding for tribal member, Billy Kane to renovate and update his bathroom and has been turned down because there was not sufficient fund in the FY 92 HIP budget to accommodate his needs; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Kane is now requesting that he be placed on the HIP FY 93 list to obtain funding to renovate the bathroom in his residence and the Tribal Council concurs with his request.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that tribal member, Billy Kane, be placed on the HIP FY 93 funding list so that he can obtain the necessary funding to renovate and make necessary repairs to the bathroom in his residence.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 10, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
