RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Catherine Hext Samletzka, Coordinator for the White Mountain Apache Headstart Program has come before the Tribal Council and advises that she was successful in obtaining a grant for the Headstart Program and the grant proposal which she drafted included a small salary increase for her position; and
- WHEREAS, she advises the Council that the Tribal Treasurer is unable to give her the increase until Tribal Council approves same; and
- WHEREAS, said increase will be entirely paid for by non-tribal
 funds; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council concludes that the increase should be granted since it does not involve tribal funds and is funded pursuant to a grant drafted and successfully obtained by Catherine Hext Samletzka; further that said salary increase should be made retroactive to July 1, 1992.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Treasurer to increase the necessary forms to implement the requested salary increase for Catherine Hext Samletzka retroactive to July 1, 1992 in accordance with the grant she obtained for the Headstart Program.

The foregoing resolution was on October 14, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
