## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is frequently asked about school boundaries for the entire reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Tribal Education Director is the appropriate person to report to the Tribal Council the location of school boundaries for the entire reservation.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Education Director to report to the Tribal Council the exact location of school boundaries for the entire reservation by the December 1992 regular Tribal Council meeting.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>October 14, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
