- Raymond Kane has come before the Tribal Council this date WHEREAS, and has requested that he be granted permission to transfer all of his sick leave to his daughter, Rayleen Benashley, who is in need of additional sick leave due to medical reasons; and
- Tribal Council Member, Nashley Tessay, Sr., also wishes WHEREAS, to transfer 80 hours of his sick leave to Rayleen Benashley for the same purpose; and
- the Tribal Council is in agreement that approval should WHEREAS, be granted to transfer the sick leave to Rayleen Benashley as requested.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the transfer of all accrued sick leave earned by Raymond Kane and 80 hours of sick leave from Nashley Tessay, Sr. to Rayleen Benashley.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Tribal Personnel Department to process the transfer of sick leave pursuant to this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on November 04, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
