RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tribal Council member Kino Kane has requested that the Tribal Council adopt a resolution requesting the Bureau of Indian Affairs to gravel the private access roads to the homesites of Bobby Johnson in Canyon Day, Udell Opah behind Hospital Housing, Carlos James, Sr. near River Road, Rolland Ethelbah at Alchesay Flats, Dorothy Lavender at Blueberry Hill, and Lincoln Johnson in Cibecue, and to report back to the Tribal Council and Councilmember Kino Kane the dates when said graveling has been accomplished; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs in said request.

- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs Roads Department to promptly gravel access roads to the homesites of Bobby Johnson at Canyon Day, Udell Opah behind the Hospital Housing, Carlos James, Sr. near River Road, Rolland Ethelbah at Alchesay Flats, Dorothy Lavender at Blueberry Hill, and Lincoln Johnson in Cibecue.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it requests the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency to report back to the Tribal Council if and when said graveling is accomplished and if it cannot be, the reasons why at the next regularly scheduled Tribal Council meeting.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>November 04, 1992</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
