- the Tribal Council is advised that there are recurring WHEREAS, erosion and flooding problems at the residence of SlimQuay and Wesley Bonito, and below Jack's Trading Post; and
- the Tribal Council is further advised that there is WHEREAS, recurring flooding at the residence of Timothy Nozie, Jr. which can be corrected by installation of a culvert; and
- the Tribal Council concludes that these problems should WHEREAS, be corrected promptly to prevent further damage to the properties.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests BIA Superintendent Ben Nuvamsa to direct Carl Christenson, Supervisor of BIA Roads Department, to correct the erosion and flooding problems at Slim Quay and Wesley Bonito residences and below Jack's Trading Post and to install a culvert to divert the flooding at the Timothy Nozie, Jr. residence.

The foregoing resolution was on November 12, 1992, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
