RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been invited to attend the inauguration of President Elect Bill Clinton, January 19, 1993; and
- WHEREAS, preliminary contacts for hotel reservations indicate that Washington D.C. and metropolitan area hotel prices exceed the current per diem rate established by the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, based upon prevailing Washington D.C. hotel rates, the Tribal Council is advised that the per diem rate for Tribal Council members attending the 1993 Presidential inauguration should be increased to \$250.00 per diem and that the Tribal budget should be amended accordingly; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with the recommendation.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby increases the per diem rate for
 Tribal Council members who will attend the 1993
 inauguration of President Elect William Clinton to
 \$250.00 per day while in Washington D.C. for the
 inauguration.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby amends the Tribal budget for FY 92-93 in accordance with this Resolution and directs the Tribal Treasurer to prepare a budget amendment in accordance with the total amount authorized by this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 02, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
