RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- Tribal Council Member Johnny Endfield, on behalf of the WHEREAS, Rainbow City, Diamond Creek, Cradleboard and Over the Rainbow communities is requesting Tribal permission to utilize \$1,500 of the Whiteriver Land Claims Fund for a Christmas party and gifts for young persons up to the age of 18 and elders over the age of 55; and
- Mr. Endfield advises the Tribal Council that he will WHEREAS. submit a petition of support of said request within ten (10) days of approval of the request; and
- Tribal Council concurs with the request. WHEREAS,
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Rainbow City, Diamond Creek, Cradleboard and Over-the-Rainbow communities to expend \$1,500 from the community's land claims fund for a Christmas party for young person up to the age of 18 and for elders over the age of 55 and to purchase gifts for said party.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 14, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
