## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- whereas, the Tribal Council has previously enacted an ordinance for the control of bingo on the reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been involved with the State of Arizona for a Class III Gaming Compact; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has the capacity, experience and background necessary to regulate Class III Gaming within the boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council has directed that the Legal Department draft an ordinance for the control and regulation of gaming on the reservation, a copy of which is attached to this resolution and incorporated by reference herein; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council concludes that the ordinance should be posted and that the Tribal Chairman, prior to posting, may make such changes to the gaming ordinance as is appropriate for the tribal government.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Council Secretary to post the proposed Gaming Ordinance of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in each district as required by the Tribal Constitution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 14, 1992</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
