RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- whereas, the Tribal Council is advised that the Arizona Commission of Indian Affairs has informed the Tribal Chairman that the terms of three Tribal representative who are members on the commission have expired; and
- WHEREAS, the Arizona Commission of Indian Affairs has suggested that the Tribal Council nominate a person from the White Mountain Apache Tribe for appointment to the Indian Affairs Commission; and
- WHEREAS, Vice Chairman, Lafe Altaha has recently completed a term as commissioner on Arizona Commission of Indian Affairs and the Tribal Council concludes that Mr. Altaha should be renominated by the Tribal Council for a seat on the commission.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby nominates Vice Chairman, Lafe Altaha for appointment to the Arizona Commission of Indian Affairs.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby urges Governor, Fife Symington to appoint Mr. Altaha to the Indian Affairs Commission.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 18, 1993</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (s) (t) (u) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
