RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal member Rose Kinney has come before the Tribal Council complaining that her ex-husband, Robert Pacheco, Sr., a non-member of the Tribe, has consistently harassed her and placed her in fear of her life; and
- whereas, she requests Tribal Council action to exclude Mr. Pacheco permanently from the Reservation; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council is advised that exclusion on nonmembers from the reservation must be pursued pursuant to the Tribal Exclusionary Ordinance and requirements thereof; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council concludes that the Tribal Attorney should investigate the basis for and determine if there is a factual basis to exclude Robert Pacheco, Sr. from the Reservation and to proceed with the exclusion if there is a legal basis therefor.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Attorney to investigate Rose Kinney's claims and determine if there is a basis under the Tribal Exclusionary Ordinance to exclude Robert Pacheco, Sr. from the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and further, that if there is a basis to exclude, that the Tribal Legal Department proceed with the exclusion pursuant to the Ordinance.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>November 03, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
