## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Canyon Day Community President, Nolan Clay, advises the Tribal Council that \$1,000 authorized by the Tribal Council for use by the Canyon Day Community for Christmas from the General Land Claims fund was not utilized for Christmas due to two (2) wakes that took place in the community; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Clay requests on behalf of the community that the Tribal Council authorize the community to utilize the \$1,000 for community activities during Easter, Valentine's Day and rodeo expenses; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs in said request.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Canyon Day Community to utilize the \$1,000 previously authorized for Christmas activities for Easter, Valentine's Day and rodeo activities.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the \$1,000 be drawn from the General Land Claims allocated to Canyon Day Community.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 05, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (i), (h) and (k) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
