

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. Callis Lupe has presented himself before the Tribal Council and on behalf of American Legion Post No. 60 requests a 12 to 17 passenger van to transport Veterans, who lack their own transportation, for medical appointments and other necessities; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Mr. Lupe's request on behalf of Apache Veterans and American Legion Post No. 60 should be granted.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the purchase or assignment of a 12 to 17 passenger van to the American Legion Post No. 60 for the purpose of providing transportation for Veterans and for use by American Legion Post No. 60 for other purposes to benefit veterans.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that American Legion Post No. 60 be responsible for the maintenance expense of said vehicle, and that they maintain a log on use of said van.

The foregoing resolution was on January 05, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (h), (i) and (k) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
