

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tribal Councilmember Randall Massey, Jr. advises the Tribal Council that barbed wire fencing along the right side of the road leading from the Whiteriver dump to Luther Ethelbah's home is presently not in use; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Massey suggests that the barbed wire be removed and donated to tribal member John Cosen to protect his cornfield; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs in said request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the removal of the barbed wire fencing along the right side of the road from the Whiteriver dump to Luther Ethelbah's home and donation of the wire to tribal member John Cosen for fencing around his cornfield.

The foregoing resolution was on January 05, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h) and (i) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
