

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Councilmember Randall Massey, Jr. advises the Tribal Council of inadequate facilities to provide large group entertainment on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Massey requests that the Tribal Council direct the Tribal Planning Department to seek funding for a covered arena similar to Scottsdale Westworld or Desert Hills Equestrian Center; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs in said request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby direct the Tribal Planning Department to seek funding for covered arena similar to that existing at Scottsdale Westworld or Desert Hills Equestrian Center for construction on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on January 05, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (b) (i) (j) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
