RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Councilmember Randall Massey, Jr. advises the Tribal Council that the fire destruction of the Tribal Executive Building mandates that a sprinkler system be installed as soon as possible in the Tribal Business office; and
- WHEREAS, Tribal Chairman Ronnie Lupe advises Mr. Massey that a plan to install a sprinkler system in the Tribal business office is already underway but that resolution by the Tribal Council directing same would be welcome; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council concurs that a sprinkler system should be installed as soon as possible for the protection of Tribal business records.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that the Tribal Treasurer authorize sufficient funding for installation of a sprinkler system as soon as possible in the Tribal Business Office.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 05, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>five</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (j), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
