RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Chief of Police, Andrew Kane, of the Whiteriver Police Department has come before the Tribal Council with the request that the Council approve the P.L. 93-638 budget submitted earlier to the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency for FY 94-95; and
- WHEREAS, a copy of this budget is attached to this resolution and incorporated by reference herein; and
- WHEREAS, the Chief of Police, Andrew Kane, states that there is sufficient budget on this contract to allow a 10% salary increase for police officers who were previously not eligible for the recent Tribal pay raise.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the P.L.93-638 budget for Law Enforcement and Detention Services for FY94-95 and it approves the 10% pay raise to police officers as proposed on the incorporated attached budget.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 10, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i) and (k) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
