

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe as the governing body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to continue the contracts for Fiscal Year 1995 and each year thereafter for Health Authority Management Unit, Health Education Program, Community Health Representative Program, Residential Alcohol Treatment Program, Emergency Medical Services, Mental Health Services and Aftercare Program; and

**WHEREAS,** the aforementioned P.L. 93-638 Indian Health Service contracts have, in the past, been successfully administered and have been recognized as mature contracts and therefore, will continue indefinitely; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has authorized the Tribal Health Authority Director to develop, plan, negotiate, execute and administer the said contracts and any amendments thereto; and

**WHEREAS,** the authority granted under this resolution to the Tribal Health Authority Director is to run concurrent with the Tribal Fiscal year beginning on May 1, 1994 and each succeeding year thereafter.


**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Health Authority Director is hereby authorized to plan, develop, and resubmit continuation budgets for the contracts.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that the Tribal Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is authorized and directed to sign Contract Modifications for the following programs:

1. Health Authority Management Unit
2. Health Education Program
3. Community Health Representatives Program
4. Residential Alcohol Treatment Programs
5. Emergency Medical Services Program
6. Mental Health Services Program
7. Aftercare Program
