- WHEREAS, said Election was held by the White Mountain Apache Tribe on Wednesday, April 6, 1994, where those Tribal Council candidates who were certified to the Tribal Council on February 3, 1994 after the Primary Election submitted their names to a vote of the people for Chairman and Vice-Chairman and for Council Offices in Districts I, II, III and IV; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Election Commission has certified to the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe the General Election Results pursuant to Section 3.6.15 F. of the Tribal Government Code and that the election is complete and has been carried out in accordance with provisions of the Tribal Constitution and Chapter 3 of the Government Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and has certified that the reservation-wide votes cast totaled 4.523 votes, and that the following number of votes were received by the individuals listed below whose names were on the ballot for the following offices:
