WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Timber Company has requested Tribal Council authorization for the Whiteriver Sawmill to haul in logs from the Cibecue Sawmill; and

WHEREAS, for the reasons explained to the Council concurs with said request; and

BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to the Fort Apache Timber Company to haul in logs from Cibecue sawmill to the Whiteriver Sawmill.

The foregoing resolution was on April 19, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and two against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (i) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
