


**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by Fernando Carroll that his son, fourteen year old, tribal member Arman Carroll was physically attacked and seriously injured in McNary on April 18, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the circumstances surrounding the attack on Arman Carroll warrants a formal investigation by the Whiteriver Police Department.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Whiteriver Police Department and Bureau of Indian Affairs Law Enforcement Department to conduct a thorough investigation of the physical attack upon Arman Carroll which took place April 18, 1994 in the town of McNary.

The foregoing resolution was on April 19, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


