RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Raymond Kane has recently undergone bypass heart surgery and will require a lengthy recuperation period before returning to work at the Tribal Chairman's Office; and
- WHEREAS, Raymond Kane's illness prior to his operation has consumed most of his sick leave; and
- WHEREAS, Kino Kane has accumulated 844 hours of sick leave, is in good health and does not believe that he will need much of this accumulated sick leave; and
- WHEREAS, extended leave without pay would place a heavy financial burden on the family of Raymond Kane; and
- WHEREAS, Kino Kane wishes to assist his brother, Raymond, by transferring 750 hours of his accumulated sick leave to Raymond and requests Tribal Council permission to do so; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with Kino Kane's request.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the transfer of 750 hours of Kino Kane's accumulated sick leave to the sick leave account of Raymond Kane to assist him in his recuperation process after his bypass heart surgery.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it directs the Tribal Human Resources Department to transfer 750 hours of sick leave from Kino Kane to Raymond Kane.

The foregoing resolution was on April 07, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (i) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
