

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, representatives of the Band Booster Club have come before the Tribal Council and have advised the Council that they are in the final stage of sending 80 students from the Whiteriver Middle School Band to the 65th Annual Durango Fine Arts Music Festival which is a three day competition to be held at the Fort Lewis College Campus in Durango, Colorado on May 5, 6, and 7, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Booster Club have requested the Tribal Council assist the Band with a donation of funds to be used for food, lodging and other direct travel expenses; and

WHEREAS, the Middle School Band has performed at regional music festivals throughout Arizona and was selected to perform at the Arizona State Fair; and

WHEREAS, attendance by the Middle School Band at the Durango, Colorado competition will have positive educational benefits that will enrich young tribal people's lives through music; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that \$3,000.00 should be appropriated to assist the Band Booster trip to Durango, Colorado and that said funds should be allocated from the general land claims fund.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the expenditure of \$3,000.00 from the tribal general land claims fund for the purpose of assisting the Whiteriver Middle School Band to attend the 65th Annual Durango Fine Arts Music Festival in Durango, Colorado on May 5, 6, and 7, 1994.

The foregoing resolution was on April 13, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (k), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


