FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, tribal members, Ronnie and Vera (Cruz) Lupe have requested Tribal Council approval to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the week-end of July 01-04, 1994; and

WHEREAS, Perry and Hedy (Beatty) Kelewood, have been chosen as Godparents and they have accepted the role; and

WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at the Old Fairgrounds in Whiteriver.

BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Ronnie & Vera (Cruz) Lupe, Sponsors, and Perry & Hedy (Beatty) Kelewood, Godparents, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the week-end of July 01-04, 1994 at the Old Fairgrounds in Whiteriver.


The foregoing resolution was on May 12, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (g) (i) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
