

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council pursuant to Resolution No. 04-94-091 established new rates effective May 1, 1994 for log cutters and fallers as follows:

<u>Tree Diameter</u>	<u>Rate Per Inch</u>	
Up to 19"	10.5¢	
19" to 29"	16.5¢	
30" and Over	18.0¢	; and

WHEREAS, issues regarding the propriety of establishing said rates have been presented to the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is concerned that the rates will be economical to the Fort Apache Timber Company, a tribal enterprise, but be fair to log fallers also; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that a committee should be appointed to study the log faller rates for the purpose of advising the Tribal Council whether the rates established by Resolution No. 04-94-091 effective May 1, 1994, should be modified or remain as adopted; and

WHEREAS, it is suggested that the committee be comprised of one or more Tribal Council members, Russell Henry of FATCO, Dennis Bierer of Tribal Forestry, Bureau of Indian Affairs representatives, and a log cutter or faller representative; and


WHEREAS, Tribal Council member Herbert Tate has volunteered to participate as a Tribal Council member with said committee.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the aforementioned persons including the Tribal Legal Department to meet and confer as soon as possible for the purpose of evaluating the log faller rates established by Tribal Council Resolution No. 04-94-091 and to report back to the Tribal Council its recommendations reference same.
