RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Councilmember Johnny Endfield advises the Tribal Council that his term on the Sherman Indian School Board has expired; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Councilmember Johnny Endfield has adequately represented the interests of the White Mountain Apache Tribe during his term on the Sherman Indian School Board and recommends that he be appointed to serve another term; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further concludes that tribal member, Doris Hinton meets the requirements of Board membership and can adequately serve as alternate to represent the interests of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reappoints Johnny Endfield to serve another term on the Sherman Indian School board; and if he is unable to serve, Doris Hinton will serve as alternate.

The foregoing resolution was on May 25, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
