RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to review its policy on compensatory time for all Tribal Enterprises, Departments and Programs; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council believes it would be in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to abolish all compensatory time until further review of the comp time procedures.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby abolishes all compensatory time and temporarily rescinds the compensatory time provisions provided for in Section 10 of the Personnel Policies and Procedures of the White Mountain Apache Tribe until further notice.
- BEIT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that tribal employees shall work only the hours scheduled by the Enterprise Managers, Program Directors and Department Heads and no further comp time shall be accrued or authorized until further notice.
- **BEIT FURTHERRESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that the provisions of this Resolution shall be effective immediately.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution does not apply to employees paid by the hour who may be paid overtime if within budget of said enterprises, program or department, and then only with written authorization from the employee's supervisor.

The foregoing resolution was on May 25, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (i) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
