
## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal Member, Consoni Hillhas come before the Tribal Council and requested that the house identified as 312 Oak Street in McNary be turned over to him; and
- WHEREAS, He advises the Tribal Council that the house is now occupied by a non-Tribal Member; and
- WHEREAS, Consoni Hill is advised by this resolution that previous requests for the house have been granted at McNary with the understanding that the land under the house remains with the Tribe and that no land assignments are being granted for the houses due to future plans for commercial development of the area; and
- WHEREAS, Consoni Hill acknowledges that information from the Tribal Council.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby donates the house known as 312 Oak Street in McNary to Consoni Hill as his personal property.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs that no land assignment can be made for the land on which the house presently stands until further notice by the Tribal Council as lands comprising McNary Townsite and lands adjacent thereto have been designated as a commercial development area.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the McNary Housing Authority Director, Matthew Hinton to remove 312 Oak Street from the Tribal Housing Rental list, and that the Legal Department prepare the necessary Bill of Sale or appropriate legal document to evident that title to 312 Oak Street in McNary has been transferred to Consoni Hill.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Legal Department to investigate how to properly evict the non-Tribal Member currently residing in the house from that location.
