## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is aware that numerous homes on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation are in need of repair; and

WHEREAS, Comp. Grant funding for such repairs are available for Mutual Help Homes.

BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority to apply for Comp. Grant funding for Mutual Help Homes to obtain monies for the repair of Tribal Member homes on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on June 01, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (j), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
