


**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

- WHEREAS,** Vonda Clarkson, Director of Tribal Programs, has come before the Tribal Council this date with a request that the Council approve funding or seek funding to build feeding facilities for the elderly feeding program; and
- WHEREAS,** Ms. Clarkson explains to the Tribal Council that presently the elderly are fed at various community buildings and there is often a conflict over the use of the buildings and the buildings are often not clean or fit for elderly feeding purposes; and
- WHEREAS,** Ms. Clarkson requests that funding be appropriated to construct facilities in Whiteriver and a smaller one in Cibecue so as to provide a healthy and clean environment for the elderly feeding program; and
- WHEREAS,** Ms. Clarkson further explains to the Tribal Council that there may be federal funding available for construction of such facilities; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council concludes that assistance should be provided and that the Tribal Planning Department should seek funding for the elderly feeding facilities.
- BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Tribal Planning Department to seek funding for construction of an elderly feeding facility in Whiteriver and in Cibecue for the elderly feeding program.

The foregoing resolution was on July 13, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a)(h)(i)(j)(s)(t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
