WHEREAS, Anthony & Sarafina Henry, have been chosen as Godparents and they have accepted the role; and

WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at Cibecue, Arizona.

BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Juna (Caddo) Tessay & Mary Jane (Tessay) Patterson, Sponsors, and Anthony & Sarafina Henry, Godparents, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the week-end of October 8-9, 1994 at Cibecue, Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 14, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (g) (i) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
