RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member, Mathew Ethelbah owns a home in Hondah Homesite, A-66; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Ethelbah explains to the Tribal Council that his driveway is extremely narrow and he is requesting permission to cut trees along the driveway to widen it sufficiently for his vehicles; and
- WHEREAS, after some discussion the Tribal Council concurs with his request on the condition that Tribal Forester Dennis Bierer or his designee supervise the falling of the trees; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further directs that Mr. Ethelbah not be charged for the tree removal.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes tribal member, Mathew Ethelbah to cut trees along his driveway in Hondah Homesite, A-66 to widen it sufficiently for his vehicles to safely utilize the driveway.
- BEIT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Mr. Ethelbah shall not be charged for the value of the trees or the labor to fall them.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 03, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
