RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member, Trudy Cromwell has come before the Tribal Council with the requests for assistance in obtaining employment; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Cromwell explains that she still lives in the rental house assigned to her deceased father and the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority has directed that she vacate the house as she is unemployed; and
- WHEREAS, if Ms. Cromwell can obtain employment, she may be able to stay in the rental unit; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to assist her in obtaining employment and is impressed by her willingness to work.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby recommends to any prospective employer, tribal or non-tribal, Ms. Trudy Cromwell be given the opportunity and chance to prove herself in any job opening that might be available.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 03, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
