RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, It has long been the policy of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that members cannot lease tribal land to non-members of the Tribe;

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to place everyone on notice of this prohibition and to reaffirm that tribal members cannot lease or sublease tribal land to non-members of the Tribe.

BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms the prohibition that no tribal member may lease or sublease any tribal land within the exterior boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation to any non-member.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 03, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (e), (h), (i), (m), (n), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
