


**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, David Dude, Sr. and Renata (Susan) Dude request that their son's, Jeremiah Dude, DOB: 07/31/1986, tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished so that he may become eligible for enrollment with the San Carlos Apache Tribe; and


WHEREAS, the necessary documents of relinquishment of headrights were read and signed by the parents, David Dude, Sr. and Renata (Susan) Dude in the presence of a Notary Public on the 19th day of July, 1994 and are attached hereto.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants relinquishment of White Mountain Apache Tribe membership to Jeremiah Dude as requested by his parents, David Dude, Sr. and Renata (Susan) Dude.

The foregoing resolution was on August 03, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article II Section 3 of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

RELINQUISHMENT OF TRIBAL HEADRIGHTS
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

I, Renata S. Dude, the parent(s) of my/our child who is an enrolled member of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE, under the age of 15 years, do hereby, of my/our own free will, as an adult over the age of eighteen years, voluntarily and with full knowledge of making this decision, request the TRIBAL COUNCIL of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE, FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION, WHITERIVER, ARIZONA, to release my/our child from the Tribal Census Rolls of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to enable my/our child to enroll with the:

San Carlos Apache Tribe

Further, I/We realize that my/our child will no longer have fishing or hunting privileges on the FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION; No homesite or farmland assignments, or claim to have titles to any resources of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE, or monies distributed pursuant to Judgement under the Indian Claims Commission Act. Further, that I must remove from the Fort Apache Indian Reservation within ninety (90) days after the Resolution date accepting my/our child's relinquishment, any livestock in said child's name. I further understand, however, that my child may reapply for enrollment in the White Mountain Apache Tribe upon reaching the age of eighteen (18), but that the Tribal Council has total, nonreviewable discretion to deny or grant said reapplication.
