## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Resolution No. 11-92-310, dated November 04, 1992 by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe requested that River Road, Old Fatco Road and Fatco Road be reconstructed; and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Fort Apache Agency, Branch of Roads is requesting a gratuitous right-of-way of 80 feet wide for the purpose of performing preliminary surveys, environmental studies, archaeological studies, soils investigation and other activities required to collect data to design street projects for River Road, Old Fatco Road and Fatco Road otherwise known as FAIR Consolidated Number 23.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Fort Apache Agency, Branch of Roads a gratuitous right-of-way of 80 feet wide for the purpose of performing preliminary surveys, environmental studies, archaeological studies, soils investigation and other activities required to collect data to design FAIR Consolidated Number 23 project.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 04, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (n), (m), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
