## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Healthy Nations Project, Health Education Program, Apache Behavioral Health Program, and the Public School Substance Abuse Program are interested in learning more about issues of adolescent risk-taking; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Mary Nell Wegner and Pam Erickson have volunteered their services to develop a tool to learn more about youth risk-taking and its potential contribution to suicide; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Wegner and Ms. Erickson will be reporting the progress and results to the Tribal Health Authority Director and the Health Advisory Board; and
- WHEREAS, the information gathered will only be utilized for local program planning and development, and any other use will require additional authorization through a Tribal Council resolution.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports the youth risk-taking project and authorizes the Tribal Health Authority Director to monitor the project closely.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby prohibits Ms. Mary Nell Wegner and Pam Erickson from publishing any of the research or data they have collected pursuant to this program in any form whatsoever without the prior written authorization of the Tribal Council.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that said project shall incorporate guidelines previously submitted to the Office of the Tribal Chairman by Pam Erickson.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 04, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for and <u>one</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (), (), () and () of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
