


**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has a strong interest in expanding the Tribe's economy, protecting cultural and historic resources, and improving governmental services; and
- WHEREAS,** expansion of these tribal activities can provide beneficial results to the Tribe in terms of increased cultural awareness, revenues and employment; and
- WHEREAS,** the development of expanded economic, cultural, and other governmental services require the establishment of new departments and positions on an exploratory basis; and
- WHEREAS,** the Budget Committee has discussed the need for the creation of key positions in the areas of tourism, cultural affairs, the Fort Apache Historic District development and Tribal roads.
- BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the appointment of Raymond Endfield as Tribal Tourism Coordinator to develop a strategic tourism plan for the development and coordination of the tourism industry on the reservation.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tribal Council approves the appointment of Ramon Riley as Cultural Resources Director with responsibility for the administration of the Tribe's cultural repatriation efforts, management of the Culture Center and Museum, and other related cultural affairs activities.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tribal Council approves appointment of Odette Fuller as Fort Apache Historic District Coordinator with responsibilities that include the oversight of the restoration of General Crook's Cabin and the development of additional Fort Apache attractions and services.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tribal Council approves the appointment of Randall Massey as Tribal Roads Coordinator assigned to the BIA Roads Department to supervise tribal employees assigned to BIA Roads Department, conduct special tribal road maintenance activities that can not be performed by the BIA and other duties that may be assigned.

The foregoing resolution was on September 08, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of five for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
