## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, by Resolution No. <u>02-93-027</u>, reappointed the Election Commission for the 1994 General Election and to continue with the study of redistricting and reapportionment; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the terms of the Election Commission have expired; and
- WHEREAS, Section 3.2.1 of the Tribal Election Code provides that the Tribal Council may extend the term of the Election Commission; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to reappoint the previous members of the Election Commission to continue with the study of redistricting and reapportionment and to extend the term of appointment to the 1996 General Election.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reappoints Rayleen Benashley, Myrna Hillyard, Paul Kuehl, Anthony Cooley, Virgil Kessay, Brenda Billy, Virginia Dalton and Hedy Kelewood to the Election Commission to serve a period of appointment until six (6) months after the 1996 General Election.

The foregoing resolution was on October 06, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (q), (r), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
