## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Jeffery M. Hopkins, M.D., has come before the Tribal Council and expressed his desire that he receive an endorsement from the Tribal Council for election to the Board of Directors for Navopache Hospital; and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Hopkins has advised Tribal Council of his concerns regarding the services provided to tribal members at Navopache Hospital; and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Hopkins has advised the Tribal Council that up to 30% of the patients seen at Navopache Hospital are tribal members, or Native Americans; and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Hopkins has assured the Tribal Council that he will undertake actions, if elected to the Navopache Hospital Board, to promote the quality of service provided to tribal members at the Hospital.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby endorses Jeffery M. Hopkins, M.D., for an elected position on the Board of Directors of Navopache Hospital.

The foregoing resolution was on November 03, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
