## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been requested by the Seven Mile Miracle Church that the church be authorized to use gravel from the Stago Borrow Pit for purposes of graveling their church parking area; and
- WHEREAS, the use of tribal resources in this manner may be authorized by the Tribal Council on a case-by-case basis; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has discussed the request and conclude the request should be granted and that Fort Apache Materials be directed to haul the gravel to the church parking area.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Seven Mile Miracle Church to use the Stago Borrow Pit as source of gravel for use at their parking lot.
- BEIT FURTHERRESOLVED by the Tribal Council that this shall not be an on-going use, but shall be a one time authorization and that such gravel shall be taken only to the extent as is reasonably necessary for this one time authorization.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs Fort Apache Materials to assist the church in hauling the gravel from the Stago Borrow Pit to the church parking lot.

The foregoing resolution was on November 05, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
