RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal Member Jeanette Childs has come before the Tribal Council with a request that she be placed at the top of the HIP list for District One for the reasons that she has family responsibilities, is asthmatic, needs oxygen by her side at all times, has a life threatening disease or condition and because she presently is renting a home which is too expensive for her; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council based upon the medical condition of Jeanette Childs, her living conditions and income, concludes that she should be placed at the top of the list for a HIP house in District One.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Bureau of Indian Affairs to place Tribal Member Jeanette Childs at the top of the list for a HIP house in District One due to the foregoing medical, financial and housing need reasons described in this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 4, 1995</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (j), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
