RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, this resolution pertains to approval of the Federal Government fiscal year 1995 Forest Management Deduction Budget and Use Plan which is administered under authority of the Code of Federal Regulations 25, Subchapter H, Section 163 and Bureau of Indian Affairs Manual 53, Supplement 3, Section 6.6; and
- WHEREAS, regulations require approval of the Forest Management Deductions Budget and Use Plan by the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council requests Bureau approval of the fiscal year 1995 budget in the amount of \$1,347,410.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the proposed Forest Management Deductions Budget and Use Plan for fiscal year 1995.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Forest Management Deductions collected shall be properly deposited and expended on items designated in the Budget and Use Plan and in accordance with 25 CFR and 53 BIAM.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 12, 1995</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
