RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that it must make a decision regarding classroom trailers which have been funded by the Facility Management Construction Center (FMCC) of the BIA for use at the Theodore Roosevelt School; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the classroom trailers should be held in abeyance but not obligated to anyone else pending a discussion by the Tribal Council on the future of Theodore Roosevelt School.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that Agency Superintendent Ben Nuvumsa, and BIA FMCC hold the classroom trailers designated for Theodore Roosevelt School in abeyance pending a decision by the Tribal Council in regards to the future of Theodore Roosevelt School and a site for said classroom trailers.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 02</u>, 1995, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (j), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
