RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Dr. Stewart Holmes has come before the Tribal Council with a request that the Council approve publication of his manuscript in respect to baby bottle tooth decay study of Tribal children on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the manuscript and concludes that publication of same may benefit Tribal children as it points out the need for greater funding from the Indian Health Service to initiate a preventative educational program regarding baby bottle tooth decay.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes publication of the manuscript prepared by Dr. Stewart Holmes in the form and content that he has presented to the Tribal Council this date.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 02, 1995</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
