- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Roger & Abilene (Burnette) Griggs, to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the week-end of July 07-09, 1995 at the Old Fairgrounds in Whiteriver.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 02, 1995</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (g) and (i) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
